1. CHECK LIST

Compulsory documents:

- Present form
- CV
- Motivation letter
- Copy of diplomas of post secondary studies. For French this includes the *baccalauréat*.
- Transcript of records of post secondary studies. Include a description of the grading system of your country (except for French). For French, include your "relevé de notes du bac"
- Certificate of English. Students must have a sufficient level of English.
- Certificate of French if any (we accept non French speakers).

Optional documents:

- one or two reference letters of a professor or a researcher who knows you well. The letter should indicate the name, the position, the address and the **email** of this person.

2. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- All the above documents should be in pdf format.
- Check that no document is missing.
- Zip all your files in a single one.
- The total size should not exceed 3MB. Look for assistance if you do not know how to reduce the size of scanned documents.
